Accurate data is the foundation of effective ESD Program Management. Therefore, it's important to have confidence in the measurements. Choosing the correct type of equipment for each measurement is also important and not always obvious.

The class will cover the correct use of static locators, resistance meters, event detectors, and how to use ionizers effectively. We will discuss the various pitfalls of commonly used instruments, and the invalid test results that can result. For instance, static locators can yield totally invalid readings when used incorrectly due to voltage suppression. What you learn will help you avoid frequently encountered auditing problems, and improve your compliance verification program.

About the Instructor

Ginger Hansel joined Motorola's Semiconductor Products Sector in 1981 as a Test Process/Equipment Engineer to analyze and improve manufacturing operations. She founded and led the manufacturing ESD control team that trained, audited, qualified materials, and established innovative solutions throughout the semiconductor sector. Under her leadership, the team reduced a 40% failure rate in one test operation to almost zero through the targeted introduction of specific ESD control materials and ESD awareness training. Ginger brought ESD awareness to her other roles as Engineering Section Leader, Technical Training Manager, QA Engineer, Business Metrics Engineer, Data and Document Control Manager, Program Manager and Technical Product Marketing Manager. In 2004, Ginger retired from Motorola/Freescale and joined Dangelmayer Associates as Director of Marketing and Program Management.

Since 1982, Ginger has been a member of the International ESD Association. She was President in 1992 and 1993, and served on the Board of Directors (1988-93, 1996-01, 2010), Steering, Technical Program, Standards, Education and other committees. She is currently the Business Unit Manager for Education. Ginger initiated the iNARTE ESD Certification program in 1992 and is a certified ESD Engineer. She also serves on the board of directors for the Texas ESD Association.

Ginger published numerous magazine articles and technical papers on effective ESD control programs and awareness training; examples include "The Production Operator: Weak Link or Warrior in the ESD Battle" and "Cost Effective Failure Analysis Method for Detecting Failure Site Associated with Extremely Small Leakage". She teaches seminars and workshops around the country and abroad.

Ms. Hansel earned a BS in Natural Sciences (Psychology) and a BS in Electrical Engineering Technology, both from the University of Houston. She received her MBA (Executive Option II program) from the University of Texas at Austin.
